<u>O P I N I O N</u>

Arthur R. Altuow, doing business as Lodi Truck Service, requests that his certificated authority be amended by excluding therefrom the right to transport fiberboard or pulpboard drums, barrels, pails or tubs, other than taper sided.

It is alleged that the transportation of said products is primarily performed by contract carriers; said commodities are light and bulky and the conditions under which they are transported vary; as a result the charges for transportation also vary; the certificated carrier is placed at a competitive disadvantage; and applicant is presently transporting said commodities and wishes to continue to do so on a competitive basis.

After consideration the Commission finds that granting such request would not be adverse to the public interest. A public hearing is not necessary.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Appendix A of Decision No. 60322, in Application No. 41446, is hereby amended by incorporating therein Second Revised Page 2 attached hereto and made a part hereof, in place of First Revised Page 2.

2. Within sixty days after the effective date hereof and on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public, applicant shall amend his tariffs presently on file with the Commission to reflect the authority herein granted.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.

C. Applicant may serve between any two points included in paragraphs A and B above or between any point in paragraph A and any point in paragraph B.

Applicant may make use of any and all streets, roads, highways, and toll bridges necessary or convenient for performance of the service herein authorized.

Applicant shall not transport any shipments of:

- 1. Used household goods and personal effects not packed in accordance with the crated property requirements set forth in Item No. 5 of Minimum Rate Tariff No. 4-B.
- Livestock, viz: bucks, bulls, calves, cattle, cows, dairy cattle, ewes, goats, hogs, horses, kids, lambs, oxen, pigs, sheep, sheep camp outfits, sows, steers, stags or swine.
- 3. Commodities requiring the use of special refrigeration or temperature control in specially designed and constructed refrigerated equipment.
- 4. Liquids, compressed gases, commodities in semiplastic form and commodities in suspension in liquids in bulk, in tank trucks, tank trailers, tank semitrailers or a combination of such highway vehicles, other than petroleum and petroleum products.
- 5. Commodities when transported in bulk in dump trucks or in hopper-type trucks.
- 6. Commodities when transported in motor vehicles equipped for mechanical mixing in transit.
- Articles of extraordinary value as set forth in Rule 3 of Western Classification No. 77, J. P. Hockler, Tariff Publishing Officer, on the issue date thereof.
- 8. Fresh or green fruits, fresh or green vegetables, or mushrooms when the point of destination of the shipment is a cannery, accumulation station, cold storage plant, precooling plant, or winery.
- 9. Metal cans (other than flattened).
- 10. Metal can tops, bottoms or ends when moving in mixed shipments with metal cans (other than flattened).
- 11. Drums, barrels, pails, or tubs, shipping, fiberboard or pulpboard, other than taper sided.
