FOURTH ORDER EXTENDING TIME

Redwood Radio Telephone Corporation, having by petition filed May 11, 1967, requested an amendment to Appendix A of Decision No. 68254 in Application No. 46721, dated November 24, 1964, to increase the rates set forth for one-way signalling service and requested a fourth extension of time if the increased rates are not authorized or denied prior to June 14, 1967, the expiration date of the certificate as set forth in the Third Order Extending Time, Decision No. 71706, and it appearing that this matter will not be resolved prior to June 14, 1967; therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the time for compliance with ordering paragraph 8 of Decision No. 68254 is extended to and including December 14, 1967.
