ORDER SETTING HEARING


The Commission's Transportation Division has prepared and distributed to interested parties a report which recommended that amendments to Minimum Rate Tariffs Nos. 7 and 17 be given consideration on a semi-annual basis. The scope of the recommendations received from the parties responding to the staff report is broader than that which is proposed by the staff.

The Transportation Division has recommended that a public hearing be scheduled for the purpose of receiving evidence relative to the need for, and advisability of, establishing procedures for considering proposed amendments to, and for promulgating modifications of, the rates and rules set forth in Minimum Rate Tariffs Nos. 7 and 17 on a periodic basis or other designated method of handling proposed tariff changes.


Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that a hearing in this proceeding on the matters referred to above be held before such Commissioner or Examiner as may be designated at a time and place to be determined.


