<u>ORDER</u>

City of San Juan Capistrano is hereby authorized to construct Avenida Aeropuerto at grade across a track of The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company in San Juan Capistrano, Orange County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. 2-198.8.

Width of crossing shall be not less than forty feet and grades of approach not greater than six percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 crossing signals (General Order No. 75-B) augmented with automatic gate arms.

Applicant shall bear entire expense of construction, also maintenance cost of the crossing outside of lines two feet outside of rails. The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company shall bear maintenance cost of the crossing between such lines. Installation cost of the automatic crossing protection shall be borne equally by the applicant and the railway. Maintenance costs of the automatic protection shall be divided in the same proportion as the cost of construction is divided, pursuant to the provisions

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of Section 1202.2 of the Public Utilities Code.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The applicant is desirous of constructing this road as soon as possible to provide access to the San Juan Capistrano Airport. The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
