SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Ordering paragraph 3 of Decision No. 72537 in this application provided for tariff filings and notice to the Commission and the public to be made not less than thirty days after the effective date of that order.

Applicant has requested, due to urgent request by certain shippers for its transportation service, that those tariff filings and the notice be authorized to be made not less than ten days after the effective date of the order.


Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that ordering paragraph 3 of Decision No. 72537 is hereby amended to provide that the tariff filings and notice to the Commission and public required thereby shall be made effective not earlier than ten days after the effective date of Decision No. 72537.


In all other respects Decision No. 72537 shall remain in full force and effect.
