ORDER REOPENING PROCEEDING

The City of Guadalupe having filed a petition for rehearing of ordering paragraph number 2 of Decision No. 69497 and good cause appearing;

IT IS ORDERED that ordering paragraph 2 of Decision No. 69497, as modified, is hereby set aside and the proceeding in Case No. 7405 reopened for further hearing limited to the issues of the need for a pedestrian bridge over the Ninth Street crossing in the City of Guadalupe and, if such bridge be required, the terms upon which such bridge shall be constructed and the allocation of the costs of construction and maintenance thereof.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in all other respects Decision No. 69497 shall remain final.


Further hearing as contemplated by this order shall be held at the time and place and before such Commissioner or Examiner as may hereafter be designated.


The Secretary is directed to cause copies of this order to be mailed to the parties forthwith, and to cause appropriate notice of
