ORDER OF SUSPENSION AND MODIFICATION

Monolith Portland Cement Company filed with the Commission on June 8, 1967, a petition seeking rehearing of Decision No. 72503 dated May 31, 1967, in the above proceeding. Pending consideration by the Commission of Monolith's petition for rehearing, the effective date of the tariff pages authorized in Appendix B of said decision will be suspended and a suspension supplement will be issued as information to the carriers and other parties affected.

In order to preserve the same basis of minimum rates on cement as those currently in effect, it will be necessary to extend, beyond July 1, 1967, the expiration date of the surcharge of one cent per 100 pounds, which is now added to the current rates in the tariff. Accordingly, a separate supplement to the tariff will be issued extending the present surcharge to and including December 31, 1967, or until the Commission otherwise orders.

Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The operative effect of Decision No. 72503 is stayed pending further order of the Commission.

2. Minimum Rate Tariff No. 10 (Appendix A of Decision No. 44633, as amended) is hereby further amended by incorporating therein Supplements Nos. 9 and 10, attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

3. Tariff publications required to be made by common carriers as a result of Ordering Paragraph 2 hereof may be made effective not earlier than the second day after the effective date of this order on not less than two days' notice to the Commission and to the public and shall be made effective not later than July 1, 1967.

4. Common carriers, in establishing and maintaining the surcharge authorized hereinabove, are hereby authorized to depart from the provisions of Section 460 of the Public Utilities Code to the extent necessary to adjust long- and short-haul departures now maintained under outstanding authorizations; such outstanding authorizations are hereby modified only to the extent necessary to comply with this order; and schedules containing the surcharge published under this authority shall make reference to the prior orders authorizing long- and short-haul departures and to this order.

5. In all other respects, Decision No. 44633, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

This order shall become effective on the date hereof.
