SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

M & R Leasing, Inc., is a highway common carrier operating under a certificate of public convenience and necessity issued by this Commission. Accordingly, its certificate will be amended to show the new corporate name and it will be ordered to amend its tariffs pursuant to General Order No. 80-A. A public hearing is not necessary.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Decision No. 65706, dated July 16, 1963, in Application No. 45469 is amended by substituting "Pacific Express Transportation" in place and stead of "M & R Leasing, Inc."

2. Within one hundred twenty days after the effective date hereof, and on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and the public, Pacific Express Transportation shall amend its tariffs on file with this Commission as required by Rule No. 6.4 of General Order No. 80-A.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
