## SUPPIEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Decision No. $\square$
72671 et al., authorized revisions in tho parcel delivery ratos in City Carriers' Tariff No. I-A and Meninum Rate Tarifes Nos. 1-B, 5 and 9-B. The docision also proviced that, in order to avoid duplication of tarifi dictribution, Minimum Rate Tarifis No. 1-E shoula be amonded by a soparate order in this procecding.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Minimum Rate Tamif No. I-B (Appendix 3 of Decision No. 65834, as amondod) is hereby further amonded by incorporating therein, to become effective Ausust 5, 2967, Third Rovised Page 22 and Fourth Revised Page 43 attached hereto and by this rererence made a part bereof.
2. Tarifi publications required to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein may be made offective not oarizor than the toath day arter the effective date of this onder on not less than ten days notice to the Commission and to the public and shall be made effective not later than August 5, 1967.
3. Common carriers, in establishing and maintaining tho rates authorized hereinabove, are hereby authorized to depart from the provisions of Section 460 of the Public Utilities code to the extent necessary to adjust long- and short-iaul departures now maintained under outstanding authorizations; such outstanding authorizations are hereby modified only to the extent necessary to comply With tins order; and scioduies containing the rates publicised under this authority shall make reference to the prion orders authorizing the long- and short-haul departures and to this order.
4. In ail other respects Decision No. 65834, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective dato of this order shall be twenty-fivo days after the date hereof.
