Investigation into the status, safety, maintenance, use and protection or closing of various crossings at grade of the lines of Southern Pacific Company, The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company, Union Pacific Railroad Company and Pacific Electric Railway Company in the County of San Bernardino, California, with various streets, roads and highways, in said county.

ORDER EXTENDING TIME

The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company has requested a 60 day extension of time within which to comply with certain conditions of Decision No. 72106, alleging that it will be impossible to complete the upgrading of protection at certain crossings within the time specified.

The railway seeks, due to shortage of materials, the extension of time for completion of the protection at the following crossings:
