 Inc. and each of them.

The Commission having ordered respondent, Premier Transport,
 Inc., in Decision 68344, ordering paragraph number 4, to make
 certain payments to purported subhaulers, and the Commission having
 issued an order extending time to comply with said direction on
 April 5, 1966, and

It further appearing that respondent Premier Transport, Inc.
 has not complied with said order, or is not able to comply with
 said order, and

It further appearing that in Decision 68344, finding paragraph
 number 3, the Commission found that

"There exists such unity of ownership, interest, and
 control between Premier Marble and Premier Limestone
 as shippers, and respondent as carrier to warrant
 disregard of their separate entities for the purpose
 of enforcing the rates prescribed by the Commission, ..."


IT IS ORDERED

1. That Premier Limestone Products, Inc. and Premier Marble
 Products, Inc., and each of them, appear by an officer or director
 or other authorized representative before Examiner Porter, or such
 other hearing officer or officers as may be designated, on Thursday,
 the 10th day of August, 1967, at 10 o'clock a.m. in the Commission
 Courtroom, 107 South Broadway, Los Angeles, California, and then

and there show cause if any they or either of them has why Premier Limestone Products, Inc. and Premier Marble Products, Inc., or either of them, should not be ordered to pay subhaulercs the amounts named in ordering paragraph number 4 of Decision 68344.

The Secretary is directed to cause a certified copy of this order to be personally served upon a duly authorized officer of Premier Limestone Products, Inc. at 909 So.
