ORDER

The State of California Department of Public Works is hereby authorized to construct a crossing at separated grades of Interstate Route 5 over the North Channel spur track of The Western Pacific Railroad Company in the City of Stockton, San Joaquín County, at the locations and substantially as shown by plans (Exhibit B, Sheets 1 and 2) attached to the application, to be identified as West Acacia Street Overhead, Crossing No. 4-100.2-AC.

Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with an agreement entered into between the parties relative thereto.

Clearances and walkways shall conform to the provisions of General Orders Nos. 26-D and 118 during construction and subsequent thereto.

Upon completion of the overpass structure, the existing Acacia Street Grade Crossing No. 4-100.2-C shall be abandoned and closed to public use and travel.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within three years unless time be extended or if conditions are not complied with. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.

Commissioner William M. Bennett, being necessarily absent, did not participate in the disposition of this proceeding.
