## SIXTH ORDER EXTENDING TIME

By Decision No. 67887, dated September 22, 1964, the Commission ordered, among other things, the installation of automatic gates on or before June 30, 1967 at Brea Canyon Road (Crossing No. B-508.0) on Southern Pacific Company's El Paso Route in the City of Industry, Los Angeles County. By application for extension of time, filed June 22, 1967, the Southern Pacific Company has requested a two months extension for the installation of automatic protection.

The Southern Pacific Company alleges that the improvement of San Jose Creek in the vicinity of the above crossing will require the construction of a shoofly track across the above road

which work is scheduled shortly and in order to avoid the expense of relocating the protection from the existing crossing, the rail-road desires to make the installation of the gates at the temporarily relocated crossing.

Good cause appearing, IT IS ORDERED that the completion date for the installation of automatic crossing gates at Brea Canyon Road (Crossing No. B-508.0) is hereby extended to August 31, 1967.
