<u>O P I N I O N</u>

Greyhound Lines, Inc. requests authority to reauthorize, revoke, revise and redescribe routes in Urban Route Group UR-10, Sacramento.

It is alleged that a new segment of Interstate Highway 80 has been completed between U.S. Highway 99 and N Street on-ramp which applicant proposes to adopt for schedules operating between Sacramento and Stockton to and from the San Joaquin Valley, and that the new freeway is safer than the present route over Twenty-ninth and Thirtieth Streets for schedules operating between L and P Streets and U.S. Highway 99.

After consideration, the Commission finds that public convenience and necessity require the granting of the application. A public hearing is not necessary.

<u>order</u>

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. A certificate of public convenience and necessity is hereby granted to Greyhound Lines, Inc., authorizing the

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establishment and operation of service as a passenger stage corporation, as that term is defined in Section 226 of the Public Utilities Code, for the transportation of passengers, baggage and express between the points and over the routes set forth in Third Revised Page 77, attached hereto and made a part hereof, as an extension and enlargement of and consolidation with, and subject to all the limitations and restrictions set forth in, the certificate granted by Decision No. 55893 and in particular subject to the provisions set forth in Section 3 of Appendix A thereof.

2. Appendix A of Decision No. 55893, as heretofore amended, is hereby further amended by incorporating therein the revisions set forth on the revised page referred to in ordering paragraph 1 hereof.

3. In providing service pursuant to the certificate herein granted, applicant shall comply with and observe the following service regulations:

- (a) Within thirty days after the effective date hereof, applicant shall file a written acceptance of the certificate herein granted.
- (b) Within one hundred twenty days after the effective date hereof, applicant shall establish the service herein authorized and file tariffs and timetables, in triplicate, in the Commission's office.
- (c) The tariff and timetable filings shall be made effective not earlier than ten days after the effective date of this order on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and the public, and the effective date of the tariff and timetable filings shall be concurrent with the establishment of the service herein authorized.
- (d) The tariff and timetable filings made pursuant to this order shall comply with

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the regulations governing the construction and filing of tariffs and timetables set forth in the Commission's General Orders Nos. 79 and 98-A.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
