Application of GREYHOUND LINES, INC., for authority to adopt Intexstate Hignway 580 (MacArthur Frecway) between Noxth MacArthur Junction, near Holils Strcet, and South Macarthur

Application No. 49353 Junction, near Dowilng Boulevard; and for incidental relief, jncluding authority to revoke, authorize, reauthorize, and redescribe routes in Route Group 12 and in Urban Route Group UR-7 (Oaicland), COunty of Alameda.

## OPINIQN

Greytound Iines, Inc., requests authority to operate between North MacAxthur Junction, near Hollis Street, and South MacArchur Junction, near Dowling Boulevard, in Oakland.

It is alleged that segments of U.S. Highway 50 have been reconstructed and/or relocated, and redesignated Interstate Highway 580 between East Bay Iraffic Distribution Structure and Tracy; and that applicant proposes to adopt Interstate Highway 580 between North MacArthur Junction and South MacArthur Junction, which is a relocaeion of U.S. Highway 50 for schedules operating between San Francisco mo Tracy.

After consideration the Comission finds that public convenience and necessity require the granting of the application. A public hearing is not necessary.
OREER

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. A certificate of public convenience and necessity is hereby granted to Greyhound Lines, Inc., authorizing the establishment and operation of service as a passenger stage corporation, as that term is defined in Section 226 of the Public Utilities Code, for the transportation of passengers, baggage and express between the points and over the routes set forth in Fifth Revised Page 27, Third Revised Page 28, Thisid Revised Page 72 and Fafth Revised Page 73, attached hereto and made a part hereof, as an extension and enlargement of and consolidation with, and subject to 211 the limitations and restrictions set forth in, the certificate granted by Decision No. 55893 and in particular subject to the provisions set forth insection 3 of Appendix A taereof.
2. Appendix A of Decision No. 55893 as heretofore amended is hereby further amended by incorporating the revisions set forth on the revised pages referred to in ordering paragraph I hereof.
3. In providing service pursuant to the certificate herein granted, applicant shall comply with and obsexve the following service regulations:
(a) Within thirty days aftex the effective date hercof, applicant shall file a written acceptance of the certificatc herein granted.
(b) Within one hundred twenty days after the effective date hereof, applicant shail establish the sexvice herein authorized and file tariffs and timetables, in triplicate, in the Comission's office.
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(c) The tariff and timetable filings shall be made effective not earlier than ten days after the effective date of this order on not less than ten days' notice to the Comission and the public, and the effective date of the tariff and timetable filings shall be concurrent with the establishment of the service herein authorized.
(d) The tariff and timetable filings made pursuant to this order shall comply with the regulations governing the construction and filing of tariffs and timetables set forth in the Commission's General Orders Nos. 79 and 98-A.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
