ORDER REVOKING OPERATING AUTHORITY

The Commission having ordered the respondent in Decision 70511 to pay certain named subhaulers \$21,020.58 and it appearing that respondent has not complied with said order, and it further appearing that respondent is not financially able to comply with said order, and it further appearing that respondent does not have on file accident liability insurance as required by Public Utilities Code 3631, and its permits having been suspended on June 22, 1966, and it further appearing that the Commission is authorized to revoke a highway permit carrier's authority for failure to comply with a Commission order pursuant to Public Utilities Code Section 3774(c);

IT IS ORDERED that

1. Radial Highway Common Carrier Permit No. 30-4132 and Highway Contract Carrier Permit No. 30-4133 issued to Trojan Trucking Services, Inc., are hereby revoked and cancelled.

2. No new permit shall be issued to Ray Walton, as an individual, or to any partnership or association in which said Walton is financially interested, or to any corporation in which said Walton is interested to the extent of five percent or more of the total value of the outstanding stock therein, unless and until respondent or Walton shall have complied with the requirements of Decision No. 70511 in this proceeding.

3. The Secretary of the Commission shall cause a copy of the foregoing order to be personally served on respondent through its president, Ray Walton.

The effective date of this order shall be thirty days after such personal service unless, before said effective date, respondent shall have filed a written request for a public hearing on this matter, in which event, the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
