ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE AUTHORITY

By Decision No. 67482 dated July 7, 1964, in Application No. 46639, Leonard F. Trew and Dorothy M. Brown, doing business as HI LINERS, were granted a passenger stage operative right authorizing seasonal sightseeing service between Fort Bragg and Noyo and between Fort Bragg and Mendocino, and it appearing that since the month of September 1965, Leonard F. Trew and Dorothy M. Brown, have not operated the passenger stage service theretofore conducted by them pursuant to the foregoing described operative right, and that since December 1965, Leonard F. Trew and Dorothy M. Brown have had no evidence on file with this Commission showing adequate protection against liability imposed by law for payment of damage for personal injury or property damage, as required by General Order No. 101-B, and that Leonard F. Trew and Dorothy M. Brown have stated that they do not intend to resume service due to lack of interest by the public in sightseeing in the Fort Bragg area; therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the passenger stage operative rights, created by Decision No. 67482 in Application No. 46639, are hereby revoked and all effective tariffs and timetables on file with the Commission in the name of Leonard F. Trew and Dorothy M. Brown are hereby canceled.
