ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE AUTHORITY

By Decision No. 70253 dated January 18, 1966, in Application No. 47927, Joseph M. and Neola F. Chappell were granted a passenger stage operative right authorizing service within the City of Vallejo and between the City of Vallejo and adjacent area, and it appearing that during the month of March 1967, Joseph M. and Neola F. Chappell, without appropriate authority, discontinued the passenger stage service theretofore conducted by them within the City of Vallejo and between the City of Vallejo and adjacent area pursuant to the foregoing described operative right, and that since March 3, 1967, Joseph M. and Neola F. Chappell have had no evidence on file with this Commission showing adequate protection against liability imposed by law for payment of damage for personal injury or property damage, as required by General Order No. 101-B, and that Joseph M. and Neola F. Chappell have expressed their desire to discontinue service due to excessive financial losses they have experienced in several years of operation; therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the passenger stage operative rights, created by Decision No. 70253 in Application No. 47927, are hereby revoked and all effective tariffs and timetables on file with the

Commission in the name of Joseph M. and Neola F. Chappell, doing business as Vallejo Interurban Transit Company, are hereby canceled.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon Joseph M. and Neola F. Chappell or to mail a certified copy thereof to Joseph M. and Neola F. Chappell at P.O. Box 14, Vallejo, California 94590, last known address as shown in the Commission's records.

The effective date of this order shall be the 20th day after such service upon Joseph M. and Neola F. Chappell or after the above mailing to Joseph M. and Neola F. Chappell, as the case may be, unless before such effective date there shall have been filed with this Commission written response to this order requesting public hearing in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
