ORDER OF DISMISSAL

This petition of the second class (Public Utilities Code, Sections 1401-1421), to have the Commission fix the just compensation to be paid by the City of Folsom for certain lands, property and rights of Natomas Water Company subsequently acquired by Southern California Water Company and located in and near the City of Folsom, comprising, generally, the water system of Southern California Water Company serving its Folsom area, was removed from the calendar on September 17, 1965 following several days of hearings, to permit the parties to conclude negotiations for a sale of the sought properties.

The negotiations culminated in an agreement for sale of essentially the same properties that are the subject of the instant petition. The Commission has authorized that agreement (Decision No. 71889, dated January 24, 1967, Application No. 48786).

Completion of the negotiated sale renders the instant petition moot.

Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that the petition of the City of Folsom herein, as amended, be and it hereby is dismissed.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
