O R D E R

State of California Department of Public Works is hereby authorized to widen three crossings at separated grades of State Route 101 over the tracks of Southern Pacific Company, in the Cities of Brisbane and South San Francisco, San Mateo County, at the locations and substantially as shown by plans (Exhibit B) attached to the application, identified as "Sierra Point Overhead" Crossing No. E-7.6-A, "South San Francisco Overhead" Crossing No. E-9.4-A and "South San Francisco Belt Railway Overhead" Crossing No. E-9.8-AC.

Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with an agreement to be entered into between the parties relative thereto, and copy of said agreement, together with plans of said crossings approved by Southern Pacific Company, shall be filed with the Commission prior to commencing construction. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the cost of construction and maintenance by further order. Clearances shall conform to the provisions of General Order No. 26-D.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within three years unless time be extended or if conditions are not complied with. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
