BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

Application of the State of California Department of Public Works for an order authorizing construction of two crossings at separated grades in the City of Sacramento whereby Interstate 880 will be carried over tracks of The Western Pacific Railroad Company, referred to as "Natomas East Canal Bridge and Overhead", and over tracks of the Sacramento Northern Railway, referred to as "Del Paso Heights Overhead".

<u>ORDER</u>

State of California Department of Public Works is hereby authorized to construct two crossings at separated grades of Interstate 880 over the tracks of The Western Pacific Railroad Company and Sacramento Northern Railway in the City of Sacramento, Sacramento County, at the locations and substantially as shown by plans (Exhibit B) attached to the application, and substantially as set forth in the application to be identified as Crossings Nos. 4-143.3-A and 8-99.5-A, respectively.

Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with an agreement to be entered into between the parties relative thereto, and copy of said agreement, together with plans of said crossings approved by The Western Pacific: Railroad Company. and Sacramento Northern Railway, shall be filed with the Commission within 180 days from the date hereof. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the cost of construction and maintenance by further order.

Clearances shall be in accordance with General Order No. 26-D, except that during the period of construction of the overheads, a clearance of not less than 21'-O" above top of rail is authorized and the carriers are authorized to operate with such reduced overhead clearance provided they issue, and file with the Commission, appropriate bulletins to train and engine crews advising

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them of the temporarily impaired clearance conditions and forbidding trainmen to ride on the tops of cars while operating beneath the structures.

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Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within three years unless time be extended or if conditions are not complied with. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
