ORDER DENYING REHEARING  
AND REOPENING PROCEEDINGS

Monolith Portland Cement Company having filed a petition for rehearing of Decision No. 72503, the Commission having considered each and every allegation thereof and being of the opinion that the petition for rehearing should be denied but that the proceeding should be reopened for receipt of further evidence with respect to costs and other rate-making factors, particularly such additional justification as may be relied upon to support the "industry proposal" made on behalf of California Trucking Association and designated cement producers,

IT IS ORDERED that said petition is denied.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the rates established by Decision No. 72503, and suspended by the timely filing of the petition for rehearing, are continued in suspension until further order of the Commission and that Case No. 5440, Petition No. 26, is reopened for the purpose of the above described further inquiry into the rates and charges for the transportation of property subject to Minimum Rate Tariff No. 10.

The Secretary is directed to cause appropriate notice of further hearing to be mailed at least ten days before such further hearing.
