
ORDER GRANTING STAY


Decision No. 72297 was suspended by timely filing of a petition for rehearing by respondent Greyhound. (Pub. Ut. Code sec. 1733.) Rehearing was denied July 18, 1967 and the decision became effective on that date. On July 20, 1967 Greyhound petitioned for an extension of time to comply with the decision, stating its intention to seek review. IT IS ORDERED that the operative effect of Decision No. 72297 is stayed pending further Commission order.
