ORDER OF REVOCATION

Pasadena City Lines, Inc., a corporation, has heretofore operated a common carrier service for the transportation of passengers in the County of Los Angeles. On July 19, 1967, pursuant to the Southern California Rapid Transit District Act of 1964, the Southern California Rapid Transit District acquired all the operating assets and contracts of applicant. Applicant will no longer conduct such services and will cease operations beginning July 30, 1967 at 12:01 a.m.

Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that the operating authority granted to Pasadena City Lines, Inc. is hereby revoked and all of

its tariffs, timetables, Powers of Attorney and concurrences on file with this Commission are hereby cancelled.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
