- 7(a) On or before September 1, 1967 A. W. Hays Trucking, Inc. shall file a written acceptance of the certificate herein granted. A. W. Hays Trucking, Inc. is placed on notice that, if it accepts the certificate of public convenience and necessity herein granted, it will be required, among other things, to comply with and observe the safety rules of the California Highway Patrol, and insurance requirements of the Commission's General Order No. 100-D. Failure to comply with and observe the provisions of General Order No. 100-D may result in a cancellation of the operating authority granted by this decision.
