ORDER AMENDING DECISION NO. 71788

Ordering paragraph 4 of Decision No. 71788 dated December 29, 1966, directed respondents to collect \$3,310.58 in undercharges. Respondents have collected \$2,880.41 of this amount.

By letter filed July 6, 1967, respondents state that all attempts to collect the remaining undercharges from Flexco Pharmaceutical Co. and Bayshore Tank & Scrap Iron Co. in the amounts of \$34.00 and \$396.17, respectively, have been unsuccessful and request that the directive to collect said undercharges be rescinded. The letter asserts that both companies have gone out of business.

It appears to the Commission that the directive to collect the balance of the undercharges should be rescinded.

IT IS ORDERED that the directive in ordering paragraph 4 of Decision No. 71788 dated December 29, 1966, to collect undercharges in the amount of \$34.00 from Flexco Pharmaceutical Co. and \$396.17 from Bayshore Tank & Scrap Iron Co. is rescinded.
