IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in all other respects said petitions for rehearing are denied.

Such limited rehearing shall be held before such Commissioner or Examiner and at such time and place as may hereafter be designated.

The Secretary shall cause appropriate notice of rehearing to be mailed at least ten days prior thereto.
