ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHT

The certificate of public convenience and necessity granted to Jack Woodmansee, doing business as Woody's Transfer, was suspended on July 24, 1966, for failure to have on file requisite evidence of liability insurance. The certificate was continued in suspension on May 25, 1967, for failure to have on file the required tariffs and further suspended on June 15, 1967, for failure to file annual reports. To date the carrier has not filed the required evidence of liability insurance, tariffs or annual report.

Jack Woodmansee having failed to have on file evidence of liability insurance, tariffs and the required annual report, the Commission finds that such failures constitute good cause for revocation of the certificate.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a highway common carrier granted to Jack Woodmansee by Decision No. 66817 dated February 18, 1964, in Application No. 45044 is hereby revoked.
