ORDER OF DISMISSAL OF PETITION

By Decision No. 70884 in this proceeding the Commission ordered the Pasadena City Lines, Inc. to purchase a certain number of new buses and established a schedule for the purchase. On July 17, 1967, the Pasadena City Lines filed a request for an extension of time in which to purchase the new buses and asked that the time be extended until January 2, 1968.

On July 27, 1967, the Commission by Decision No. 72820, in Application No. 49563, revoked all of the operating authorities, tariffs and timetables of the Pasadena City Lines, Inc. because the operation had been sold to the Southern California Rapid Transit District, effective July 30, 1967.

Good cause appearing, IT IS ORDERED that the request for extension of time to purchase new buses filed with this Commission on July 17, 1967, be, and it is, hereby dismissed. The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
