THIRD ORDER EXTENDING TIME

R. L. Mohr, dba Advanced Electronics, by petition filed July 3, 1967, requested a further extension of time limit mentioned in Ordering Paragraph 4 of Decision No. 66101, dated October 1, 1963, to and including October 21, 1968, to allow applicant sufficient time to complete the proceedings before the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) involving its application for an FCC construction permit and frequency assignment. By the terms of that order, applicant cannot exercise said authority until a construction permit and license has been obtained from the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) for the radio facilities it proposes to operate; therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the time for compliance with Ordering Paragraph 4 of Decision No. 66101 is extended to and including October 21, 1968.

In all other aspects, Decision No. 66101 shall remain in full force and effect.
