

<u>ORDER</u>

Southern Pacific Company is hereby authorized to construct an additional drill track at grade across Pepper Drive at Edison in Kern County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. B-319.9. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the road now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding two percent. The existing crossing is presently protected by two Standard No. 3 crossing signals (General Order No. 75-B) supplemented with automatic gate arms. Additional protection for the new drill track shall consist of one Standard No. 3 crossing signal to be installed on the northerly side of the new drill track. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with.

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Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
