## OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. $\qquad$ 72939 , entered today, in this proceeding, the minimum rates in the San Francisco Bay Area are revised. The decision found that in ordex to avoid duplication of tariff distribution City Carriexs' Tariff No. I-A should be amended by separate order; cherefore,

## IT IS ORDERED that:

1. City Carriers' Tariff No. 1-A (Appendix A of Decision No. 41363, as amended) is hereby further ameaded by incorporating therein, to become effective September 23,1967 , the revised pages Iisted in Appendix A, which pages and appendix are attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.
2. In all other respects, said Decision No. 41363, as amended, shall remaln in full force and effect.
