ORDER GRANTING REHEARING
AND LEAVE TO INTERVENE

A petition for rehearing of Decision No. 72404 having been filed by Southern Pacific Company, and petitions in intervention having been filed by the State Department of Public Works, City of Anaheim, The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company, and Union Pacific Railroad Company, which latter petition is joined in by Western Pacific Railroad Company, the Commission having considered said petitions, and good cause appearing, IT IS ORDERED as follows:

1. Rehearing of Decision No. 72404 is granted, limited to oral argument before the Commission en banc regarding the issue of apportionment of costs of relocation, installation, and maintenance of automatic protection, said rehearing to be had at such time and place as may hereafter be designated.

2. The petitions to intervene filed by the State Department of Public Works, the City of Anaheim, The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company, Union Pacific Railroad Company, and Western Pacific Railroad Company, are granted.

The Secretary is directed to cause appropriate notice of rehearing to be mailed at least ten (10) days before such rehearing.
