Application of the City of San Jose, a municipal corporation of the State of California, for permission to widen an existing grade separation structure under the Southern Pacific Company's railroad tracks at Willow Street, in the City of San Jose, State of California, PUC Crossing No. E-48.4-B.

QRDER

City of San Jose is hereby authorized to reconstruct a crossing at separated grades of Willow Street under the tracks of Southern Pacific Company, in San Jose, Santa Clara County, at the location and substantially as shown by plans (Exhibit A) attached to the application, to be identified as Crossing No. E-48.4-B. Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with an agreement to be entered into between the parties relative thereto, and copy of said agreement, together with plans of said crossing approved by Southern Pacific Company, shall be filed with the Commission prior to commencing construction. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the cost of construction and maintenance by further order. Clearances shall conform to the provisions of General Order No. 26-D.

This project was assigned Priority No. 12 in the Commission's Decision No. 71701 in Case.No. 8496, dated December 13, 1966, which established the 1967 grade separation priority list pursuant to Section 189 of the Streets and Highways Code.
