SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By Decision No. 70866, dated June 15, 1966 the Commission ordered, among other things, the installation of a median strip at Judson Street (Crossing No. 2U-10.4) on The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company and (Crossing No. BP-549.4) on the Southern Pacific Company in the City of Redlands.

The city by letter dated July 21, 1967 requests that such median strip be deleted from the order alleging that the gate arms are of sufficient length that median is not necessary, that it is not consistent with the requirements for similar crossings in the city, that the median serves no useful purpose and by itself would be a hazard to motorists and that the cost is very high considering its doubtful value.

The Santa Fe and the Southern Pacific Company by letters dated June 29, 1967 and July 18, 1967, respectively, advised that each would not object to the deletion of the median from the Commission order.

The staff has reviewed the city's request and recommends that it be granted.

It appears that the request is reasonable. Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that ordering Paragraph 5 of Decision No. 70866 which now includes the following sentence:

"A median strip shall be constructed from north of Santa Fe line across the Southern Pacific line."

and ordering Paragraph 6 of the same Decision which includes the following portion of sentence:

".....and the cost of the median strip at Judson Street shall be borne by the city."

are hereby amended whereby such sentence and portion of sentence are deleted from ordering Paragraphs 5 and 6.

In all other respects Decision No. 70866 shall remain in full force and effect.
