SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Tanner Motor Tours, Ltd., is a passenger stage corporation operating under various certificates of public convenience and necessity issued over a period of years by this Commission. The carrier recently filed Application No. 48877 with this Commission for authority to extend its operations to provide a sightseeing service between Anaheim-Buena Park and Marineland. Attached to the application were its amended Articles of Incorporation changing its corporate name to The Gray Line Tours Company. The carrier has amended its tariff on file with the Commission pursuant to General Order No. 79. Accordingly, the certificates in question will be amended to show the new corporate name. A public hearing is not necessary.

2. In all other respects, the decisions referred to in Ordering Paragraph 1 above shall remain in full force and effect.
