ORDER

The County of Santa Cruz is hereby authorized to construct Industrial Road at grade across a spur track of Southern Pacific Company near Watsonville, Santa Cruz County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. EC-103.0-C.

Width of crossing shall be not less than 24 feet and grades of approach not greater than one percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Southern Pacific Company shall spike the switch leading to said spur track crossing until the spur track is placed in service at which time Southern Pacific Company, at its expense, shall install two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) reflectorized with reflex-reflective sheet material. The Southern Pacific Company shall notify the Commission when the spur track is placed in service.

Applicant shall bear entire expense of construction, also maintenance cost of the crossing outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost of the crossing between such lines.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The county desires to immediately proceed with construction of the road according to agreement with the property owners to be served. The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
