SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 72950 dated August 22, 1967, in the above proceeding, the Commission authorized an increase in the minimum rates and charges named in Minimum Rate Tariff No. 9-B applicable to the transportation of general commodities within the San Diego Drayage Area.

It has come to the Commission's attention that common carriers in making their tariff filings pursuant to Decision No. 72950, supra, would be unable to comply with both the effective date of the increased minimum rates and charges and still provide for ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public in connection with their tariff publications.

Accordingly, the Commission's order in Decision No. 72950, supra, will be amended to provide for five (5) days' notice in connection with tariff filings either required or authorized to be made by common carriers.

Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Decision No. 72950 dated August 22, 1967, in the above proceeding, is hereby amended by substituting the following ordering paragraph in place and stead of Ordering Paragraph No. 4 thereof:

"4. Tariff publications required or authorized to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein may be made effective not earlier than the fifth day after the effective date of this order, on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public; that such tariff publications as are required shall be made effective not later than September 23, 1967, and that as to tariff publications which are authorized but not required, the authority herein granted shall expire unless exercised within sixty days after the effective date hereof."

2. In all other respects, Decision No. 72950 shall remain in full force and effect.

This order shall become effective on the date hereof.
