Application of the State of California Department of Public Works for an order authorizing construction of a crossing at separated grades whereby a county road will be carried over tracks of the Southern Pacific Company in San Joaquin County, referred to as "Milgeo Avenue Overcrossing".	}	Application No. 49534 (Filed July 11, 1967)
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O R D E R

The State of California Department of Public Works is hereby authorized to construct a crossing at separated grades of Milgeo Avenue over the track of Southern Pacific Company near the City of Ripon in San Joaquin County at the location and substantially as shown by plans (Exhibit B) attached to the application to be identified as Milgeo Avenue Overcrossing No. B-102.6-A.

Clearances shall be in accordance with General Order No. 26-D except that during the period of construction a clearance of not less than 21'0" above top of rail is authorized and Southern Pacific Company is authorized to operate with such reduced overhead clearance provided it issues and files with the Commission appropriate bulletins to train and enginemen advising them of the temporarily impaired clearance condition and forbidding trainmen to ride on the tops of cars while operating beneath the structure.

Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with an agreement to be entered into between the parties relative thereto and a copy of said agreement together with plans of said crossing approved by Southern Pacific Company, shall be filed

with the Commission within 180 days from the date hereof. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the cost of construction and maintenance by further order.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within two years unless time be extended or if conditions are not complied with. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
