ORDER

Southern Pacific Company is hereby authorized to construct two additional spur tracks at grade across California Street to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. B-521.2-C and to construct a spur track at grade across Monterey Avenue to be identified as Crossing No. B-521.28-C in Ontario, San Bernardino County, at the locations described in the application. Construction of said crossings shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the streets now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadways and with grades of approach not exceeding two percent. Protection at each crossing shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) reflectorized with reflex-reflective sheet material. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with.

Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The Orange Products Division, Sunkist Growers is in need of immediate service in order to avoid expensive delay in operation of its warehouse.
