SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER GRANTING MODIFICATION

By Decision No. 72120 the Commission on March 7, 1967, authorized the County of Ventura to construct Cochran Street at grade across a spur track of Southern Pacific Company in the Town of Simi to be identified as Crossing No. E-437.6-C.

The order provided that the crossing be protected by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals. It has now developed that the spur track is proposed to be abandoned during 1968.

Applicant has requested the Commission to modify Decision No. 72120 by substituting Standard No. 1 crossing signs for the required Standard No. 8 flashing light signals on the basis that it is not economically justified to install the flashing light signals for the period before abandonment of the spur track.

Southern Pacific Company is agreeable to the modification requested by applicant and is further agreeable to bringing the train to a stop before entering the crossing and having a member of the train crew protect the train move.

Good cause appearing, IT IS ORDERED that the County of Ventura is hereby authorized to open the Cochran Street grade

crossing, Crossing No. E-437.6-C, across Southern Pacific Company's spur track to vehicular traffic with protection to consist of two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) with reflex reflecting sheet material.

No train, engine, motor or car shall be operated over said crossing unless said train, engine, motor or car shall be first brought to a stop and traffic on the highway protected by a member of the train crew or other competent employee of the railroad acting as a flagman.

In all other respects, Decision No. 72120 is in full force and effect. The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
