ORDER EXTENDING TIME

By Decision No. 67782 dated September 1, 1964, Pacific Gas and Electric Company was authorized to sell and convey to the City of Santa Clara the electric distribution facilities located in the area known as Jefferson No. 2 and Jefferson No. 30B Annexation in the City of Santa Clara. The decision states that the authority granted shall expire in the event that City does not consummate the purchase of this property within two years after the date of the decision.

Applicants, by order dated September 6, 1966, were granted an extension of time to and including September 1, 1967, for the consummation of the sale pursuant to a petition filed August 5, 1966, which stated that City was in the process of acquiring rights-of-way for tie lines to take over the load.

Pacific, by petition filed July 27, 1967, requests additional time to and including September 1, 1968, to consummate the sale. Pacific states it has been informed by City that construction of tie lines to take over the load has been delayed by freeway construction in the area.

In the circumstances, the Commission finds that the requested extension of time should be granted.

IT IS ORDERED that the time for consummation of the authority granted by Decision No. 67782 is extended to and including September 1, 1968.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
