## ORDER AMENDING DECISION NO. 72645

By Decision No. 72645, respondent was found to have charged less than the prescribed rates in connection with certain shipments in the totel amount of $\$ 2,801.12$. Respondent was directed to collect said undercharges. Respondent was fined in the amount of the undercharges and an additional punitive fine in the amount of $\$ 1,000$ was imposed. The total amount of the fine was $\$ 3,801.12$.

By letter dated June 29, 1967, respondent points out that it is unable to collect $\$ 953.89$ o: said undercharges and requests that the fine be reduced by this amount.

We find that respondent is unable to collect undercharges in the total amount of $\$ 953.89$ on the skipments referred to in respondent's letter and conclude that the directive to collect said undercharges should be rescinded and that the amome of fine respondent is directed to pay should be redreed by said amount to $\$ 2,847.23$.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Ordering paragraph 1 of Decision No. 72645 dated June 20 , 1967, in Case No, 8268 , is amended to provide that the amount of fine respondent shall pay to this Comission is $\$ 2,847.23$.
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2. Ordering paragraph 2 of said Decision No. 72645 is amended to provide that undercharges on the shipments referred to in respondent's letter in the amount of $\$ 953.89$ need not be collected.
3. In all other respects, said Decision No. 72645 shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
