ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHT

Lawrence T. Lasagna, an individual, possesses a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a highway common carrier for the transportation of potatoes between the Perris and San Jacinto area and Los Angeles.

By letter dated January 16, 1967, Lawrence T. Lasagna informed the Commission that his business is now incorporated and that he has changed his radial highway common carrier and highway contract carrier permits from an individual to corporate ownership and in addition, has requested that his highway common carrier certificate be revoked.

In the circumstances, it appears, and the Commission finds, that revocation of the certificate of public convenience and necessity requested by the above-named carrier will not be adverse to the public interest. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that his certificate should be revoked and that his tariff applicable to transportation services performed thereunder should be canceled.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a highway common carrier granted to Lawrence T. Lasagna by Decision No. 53259, dated June 19, 1956, as amended by Decision No. 53631, dated August 28, 1956, in Application No. 36507, is hereby revoked.

2. Local Commodity Tariff No. 1, Cal.P.U.C. No. 1, of Lawrence T. Lasagna is hereby canceled.



The effective date of this order shall be the thirtieth day after such service upon Lawrence T. Lasagna or after the above mailing, as the case may be, unless before such effective date there shall have been filed with this Commission a written request for public hearing, in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.




