## ORDER

The City of San Jose is hereby authorized to widen the existing crossing at separated grades of Park Avenue under the tracks of Southern Pacific Company in the City of San Jose, County of Santa Clara, at the location and substantially as shown by plan (Exhibit A) attached to the application, identified as Crossing No. E-47.1-B. Construction and maintenance expenses shall be borne in accordance with an agreement to be entered into between the parties relative thereto and a copy of said agreement, together with plans of said crossing approved by Southern Pacific Company shall be filed with the Commission within 180 days of the date hereof. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the cost of construction and maintenance by further order. Clearances and walkway adjacent to Southern Pacific Company's tracks shall conform to the provisions of General Order Nos. 26-D and 118 during construction, and subsequent thereto.

Within 30 days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This

authorization shall expire if not exercised within two years unless time be extended or if conditions are not complied with.

The effective date of this order shall be 20 days after the date hereof.
