## SUPRIEMENTAL ORINION AND ORDER

Decision No. 73050 entered today in Case No. 5432
et al. mended the rules of City Carriers' Tariff No. I-A and Minimum Rate Tariffs Nos. 2-B, 2, 3-A, 4-B, 5, 6-A, 7, 8, 9-B, 10, 11-A, 22, 13, 14-A, 15 and 17 by providing for the retention of shipping and other written documents.

The decision also provided that, in order to avoid duplication of tariff distribution, Minimum Rate Tariff No. 15 should be amended by a separate order in this proceeding.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Ninimurn Rate Tariff No. 15 (Appendix B to Decision No. 65072, as amended) is hereby further amended by incorporating therein to become effective October 14; 1967. First Revised Page 10 attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.
2. Tariff pubications required to be made by comon carriers as a result of the ordex herein may be made effective not earlier than the fifth day after the effective date of this order on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public and shall be made effective not later than octobex 14, 1967.
3. Common carriers, in establishing and maintaining the rule authorized hereinabove, are hereby authorized to depart from the provisions of Section 460 of the public Utilities code to the extent necessary to adjust long- and short-haul departures now maintained under outstanding authorizations; such outstanding authorizations are hereby modified only to the extent necessary to comply with this order: and schedules containing the rule published under this authority shall make reference to the prior orders authorizing long- and short-haul departures and to this order.
4. In all other respects Decision No. 65072, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

This order shall become effective twenty-five days after the date hereof.
