crossing between the mainline tracks
of the Southern Pacific Company and
Sanjon Road in the City of San Buena-
ventura.

O R D E R

City of San Buenaventura is hereby authorized to alter the crossing at separated grades of Sanjon Road under the tracks of Southern Pacific Company, in San Buenaventura, Ventura County, at the location and substantially as shown by plans (Exhibit C) attached to the application identified as Crossing No. E-398.4-B.

Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with an agreement to be entered into between the parties relative thereto, and copy of said agreement, together with plans of said crossing approved by Southern Pacific Company, shall be filed with the Commission within 180 days from the date hereof. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the cost of construction and maintenance by further order. Clearances shall conform to the provisions of General Order No. 26-D.

Grade separation project of Sanjon Road has been established as Priority No. 4 by Decision No. 71701 in Case No. 8496 pursuant to Statutes 1957, Chapter 2091, amended Statutes 1959, Chapter 1763.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This

authorization shall expire if not exercised within three years unless time be extended or if conditions are not complied with. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
