ORDER EXTENDING PERIOD OF SUSPENSION

By an order of suspension and investigation, issued May 23, 1967, certain tariff sheets of General Telephone Company of California filed by its predecessor, California Water and Telephone Company, under Advice Letter No. 486, were suspended until September 23, 1967, pending public hearing and further order of the Commission. It appears that conclusion of the matter may not be accomplished by September 23, 1967.

Good cause appearing therefor,

IT IS ORDERED that the operation and effectiveness of the tariff sheets filed under respondent's Advice Letter No. 486 are hereby suspended, as provided by statute, for an additional period of six months to and including March 23, 1968, unless otherwise hereafter ordered.
