O P I N I O N

Hulsman Transportation Co., a corporation, presently operating as a highway common carrier between various points within the State, requests that its operating authority be amended by deleting therefrom the transportation of lift truck pallets, platforms, or skids.

It is alleged that originally the transportation of lift truck pallets, platforms or skids was included in the operating rights because there was a heavy movement of glass bottles to Asti for the account of Petri Wine Company, and most of the shipments were loaded on pallets. After delivery of the bottles in Asti around two truckloads of empty pallets per week were returned to point of origin for further use. The Petri Wine Company has moved its operations from Asti to Madera. Consequently, there is no longer a movement of glass bottles to Asti and applicant is no longer called upon to transport empty pallets. If such a movement is tendered, shipments will move under permitted carrier rights of applicant, at rates no lower than those prescribed as minimum by the Commission.

After consideration, the Commission finds that such request is not adverse to the public interest and concludes that the application should be granted. A public hearing is not necessary.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Appendix A of Decision No. 52262, dated November 22, 1955, in Application No. 36343, as heretofore amended, is further amended by incorporating therein Third Revised Page 1, attached hereto, in revision of Second Revised Page 1.

2. Within one hundred twenty days after the effective date hereof, and on not less than thirty days' notice to the Commission and to the public, Hulsman Transportation Co., shall amend its tariff presently on file with the Commission to reflect the authority herein granted.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.

Petroleum or Petroleum Products, in packages, including compounded oils and greases having a petroleum base, as listed under that heading in Items Nos. 36390 through 36465 of Western Classification No. 75, Cal. P.U.C. No. 8, J. P. Hackler, Tariff Publishing Officer, on the issue date thereof, and in Supplement No. 46 thereto.
3. Animal and Poultry Feeds, as listed under that heading in Item No. 400 of Exception Sheet No. 1-S, Cal. P.U.C. No. 193, of J. P. Haynes, Agent, on the issue date thereof.
4. Roofing, Building or Paving Materials, as listed under that heading in Item No. 1110 of Exception Sheet No. 1-S, Cal. P.U.C. No. 193, of J. P. Haynes, Agent, on the issue date thereof.
5. Wine, Glass Bottles, Iron or Steel Shipping Barrels, Common Salt, Asphalt, and Hydraulic, Masonry, Mortar, Natural or Portland Cement, in sacks.
