O R D E R

Los Angeles County Flood Control District is hereby authorized to temporarily relocate, approximately 50 feet southerly, the mainline track of the Brea Canyon Road crossing at grade to a shoofly track of Southern Pacific Company in connection with the construction of San Jose Creek from Nogales Street to Benton Road in the City of Industry, Los Angeles County, to be identified as Crossing No. B-508.01. Upon completion of San Jose Creek, applicant is further authorized to relocate the temporary grade crossing approximately 45 feet northwesterly to the permanent location of the re-aligned Brea Canyon Road to be identified as Crossing No. B-508.0.

The crossings are to be constructed as described and substantially as shown in the application. Width of the crossings shall be not less than 24 feet and grades of approach not greater than 2 percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection at each crossing shall be by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B) augmented with automatic gate arms.

Construction expense shall be borne in accordance with an agreement entered into between the parties or if they fail to

agree, by further order of the Commission. Maintenance cost of the crossings outside of lines two feet outside of rails shall be borne by the public agency. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost of the crossings between such lines. Maintenance cost of the automatic crossing protection shall be apportioned 50 percent to Southern Pacific Company and 50 percent to the public agency pursuant to Decisions Nos. 72226 and 67887 in Case No. 7521.

Upon completion of the permanent relocated crossing the temporary crossing shall be physically removed.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
